IL-5 is a lineage-specific cytokine involved in the development and stimulation of eosinophils, and has been linked with diseases involving abnormally high levels of eosinophils, including parasitic infections and allergic airways eosinophilia, the major pathological symptom of allergic asthma. **ELISA** This antibody may be used in an indirect ELISA or as a capture reagent in a sandwich ELISA with AHP1034B as the detection antibody **Further Reading** 1.
