Specificity **Goat anti Bovine Interleukin-8** recognizes bovine interleukin-8 (IL-8), also known as C-X-C Motif Chemokine Ligand 8 (CXCL8).

Bovine IL-8 is produced by macrophages and released from several cell types in response to an inflammatory stimulus. IL-8 is a member of the chemokine family and as chemotactic factor attracts neutrophils, basophils, and T cells but not monocytes.

ELISA This product may be used as a detection reagent in a sandwich ELISA together with [AHP2817](#) as the capture reagent. [PBP039](#) may be used as a standard.

Storage Store at +4°C. DO NOT FREEZE.
This product should be stored undiluted. Should this product contain a precipitate we recommend microcentrifugation before use.
