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**Specificity** **Goat anti Dog interleukin-1RA antibody** recognizes canine interleukin-1 receptor antagonist, a 16.7 kDa protein belonging to the IL-1 cytokine family.

Canine IL-1RA is secreted by several cell types, including epithelial cells and adipocytes. IL-1RA functions by inhibiting the pro-inflammatory effects of both IL-1 $\alpha$  and IL-1 $\beta$ .

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**ELISA** This product may be used as a detection antibody in a sandwich ELISA together with [AHP2979](#) as the capture reagent. Recombinant Dog interleukin-1RA ([PDP012](#)) may be used as a standard.

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**Storage** Store at +4°C. DO NOT FREEZE.  
This product should be stored undiluted. Should this product contain a precipitate we recommend microcentrifugation before use.
