Specificity **Rabbit anti Human FOXM1 antibody** recognizes forkhead box protein M1, also known as M-phase phosphoprotein 2 or MPM-2 reactive phosphoprotein 2.

FOXM1 is a member of the FOX family of transcription factors ([Korver et al. 1997](#)) and plays a key role in cell cycle progression, maintenance of chromosomal segregation and genomic stability ([Laoukili et al. 2005](#)). In humans, aberrant levels of FOXM1 have been observed in a number of cancers, including basal cell carcinoma and cancers of the liver ([Kalinichenko et al. 2004](#)), lung ([Kim et al. 2006](#)) and colon ([Douard et al. 2006](#)).

Storage This product is shipped at ambient temperature. It is recommended to aliquot and store at -20°C on receipt. When thawed, aliquot the sample as needed. Keep aliquots at 2-8°C for short term use (up to 4 weeks) and store the remaining aliquots at -20°C.

Avoid repeated freezing and thawing as this may denature the antibody. Storage in frost-free freezers is not recommended. Should this product contain a precipitate we recommend microcentrifugation before use.
