A monovalent human recombinant Fab (kappa light chain) selected from the HuCAL® phage display library, expressed in *E. coli*. The antibody is tagged with a DYKDDDDK tag and a HIS-tag (HHHHHH) at the C-terminus of the antibody heavy chain. This antibody is supplied as a liquid.

The antibody can be used to measure the levels of rituximab and biosimilar products in bioanalytical assays.</p> <p>This antibody may be used as the capture antibody in a pharmacokinetic bridging ELISA in conjunction with MCA2260 as the detection antibody.</p> <p>Rituximab (reference product branded as Rituxan) is a chimeric mouse/human monoclonal antibody approved for the treatment of certain autoimmune diseases and cancer, including non-Hodgkin's lymphoma, chronic lymphocytic leukemia and rheumatoid arthritis. The antibody is specific for the cell surface protein CD20, which is widely expressed on B cells.
