<b>Specificity</b>	<p><b>Human Anti-Avelumab Antibody, clone AbD40526ia</b> is a paratope specific, inhibitory anti-idiotypic antibody (Type 1) that specifically recognizes the free human monoclonal antibody drug avelumab. The antibody does not recognize free PD-L1 nor avelumab in complex with PD-L1. This antibody can be used to measure free avelumab levels in serum from patients.</p> <p>This antibody is available as a full length IgG1 antibody (HCA398) for use in ADA assays.</p> <p>Avelumab (Bavencio) is a human IgG1/lambda antibody with allotype IGHG1*05 (G1m17,1). It binds to programmed death-ligand 1 (PD-L1, CD274) on tumor cells, blocking its interaction with PD-1 and B7-1 receptors on T-lymphocytes. PD-L1 is an immune checkpoint protein expressed on tumor cells and tumor-infiltrating immune cells that down regulates T-cell function, so by blocking these receptors anti-tumor T-cell activity can be restored. In vitro, the drug has been shown to stimulate natural killer cell-mediated direct tumor cell lysis by inducing antibody-dependent cell-mediated cytotoxicity. Avelumab has been approved both as monotherapy for the treatment of adult patients with metastatic Merkel cell carcinoma (MCC) and for the treatment of advanced Renal Cell Carcinoma (RCC).</p>
<b>Affinity</b>	<p>The monovalent intrinsic affinity of Human anti-Avelumab Antibody, clone AbD40526ia was measured as <math>K_D = 6 \text{ nM}</math> by real time, label-free molecular interaction analysis on immobilized avelumab.</p>
<b>ELISA</b>	<p>This product may be used to develop and calibrate immune response assays to measure the anti-drug antibody (ADA) response in patient sera together with <a href="#">HCA396</a> and <a href="#">HCA397</a>. Protocol: <a href="#">ADA bridging ELISA</a></p>
<b>Storage</b>	<p>This product is shipped at ambient temperature. It is recommended to aliquot and store at <math>-20^\circ\text{C}</math> on receipt. When thawed, aliquot the sample as needed. Keep aliquots at <math>2-8^\circ\text{C}</math> for short term use (up to 4 weeks) and store the remaining aliquots at <math>-20^\circ\text{C}</math>.</p> <p>Avoid repeated freezing and thawing as this may denature the antibody. Storage in frost-free freezers is not recommended.</p>
