<b>Specificity</b>	<p><b>Human Anti-Obinutuzumab Antibody, clone AbD50319ia</b> is a paratope specific, inhibitory, anti-idiotypic antibody (Type 1) that specifically recognizes the free human monoclonal antibody drug obinutuzumab, and its biosimilar products. Consequently, this antibody can be used to measure free obinutuzumab levels in serum from patients.</p> <p>Clone AbD50319ia (HCA403) is a fully human recombinant monoclonal antibody with IgG1 isotype and is suitable as a positive control or calibrator in an anti-drug antibody (ADA) assay.</p> <p>Obinutuzumab (trade name Afutuzumab) is a Fc-glyco-engineered monoclonal IgG1/kappa antibody. It specifically targets the extracellular loop of the CD20 transmembrane antigen on the surface of non-malignant and malignant pre-B and mature B-lymphocytes, but not on hematopoietic stem cells, pro-B-cells, normal plasma cells or other normal tissue. In nonclinical studies, Obinutuzumab induces direct cell death and mediates antibody dependent cellular cytotoxicity (ADCC) and antibody dependent cellular phagocytosis (ADCP) through recruitment of FcγRIII positive immune effector cells. In addition, in vivo, Obinutuzumab mediates a low degree of complement dependent cytotoxicity (CDC). Hence, it is an immunosuppressive drug. Obinutuzumab is indicated for the combination treatment of patients with chronic lymphocytic leukemia and follicular lymphoma.</p> <p><a href="#">View a summary of all anti-obinutuzumab antibodies.</a></p>
<b>Affinity</b>	The monovalent intrinsic affinity of Human anti-Obinutuzumab Antibody, clone AbD50319ia was measured as $K_D = 0.562$ nM by real time, label-free molecular interaction analysis on immobilized obinutuzumab.
<b>ELISA</b>	Clone AbD50319ia may be used to develop and calibrate immune response assays to measure the anti-drug antibody (ADA) response in patient sera together with clone AbD50514ia ( <a href="#">HCA404</a> ) and clone AbD50104ia ( <a href="#">HCA405</a> ). Protocol: <a href="#">ADA bridging ELISA</a>
<b>Storage</b>	<p>This product is shipped at ambient temperature. It is recommended to aliquot and store at -20°C on receipt. When thawed, aliquot the sample as needed. Keep aliquots at 2-8°C for short term use (up to 4 weeks) and store the remaining aliquots at -20°C.</p> <p>Avoid repeated freezing and thawing as this may denature the antibody. Storage in frost-free freezers is not recommended.</p>
