Specificity	<b>Rat anti Dog CD5 antibody, clone YKIX322.3</b> recognizes canine CD5, a 67 kDa cell surface type 1 transmembrane glycoprotein also known as lymphocyte antigen T1, Ly-1 or Leu-1. CD5 is expressed on the surface of T-cells and thymocytes, CD5 is also expressed by NK cells at low levels (Huang <i>et al.</i> 2008). Rat anti dog CD5, cloneYKIX322.3 was clustered as canine CD5 in the First Canine Leucocyte Antigen Workshop (Cobbold <i>et al.</i> 1994).
	In a study of 73 cases of canine chronic lymphocytic leukemia (CLL) CD5 expression was absent on all cases of B-cell CLL as defined by CD21 expression and lack of CD3 or other T cell antigen expression ( <u>Vernau and Moore 1999</u> ). Rat anti dog CD5 serves as a useful marker for the discrimination of canine leukemias of differing origins ( <u>Deravi <i>et al.</i> 2017</u> ).
