Fusion Partners	Spleen cells from immunised Balb/c mice were fused with cells of the mouse NS1 myeloma cell line.
Specificity	Mouse anti Histidine tag antibody, clone AD1.1.10, recognizes proteins and peptides containing the motif H-H-H-H-H and is therefore of value in detecting proteins containing histidine tags. Clone AD1.1.10 has been used to detect and purify histidine-tagged proteins expressed in mammalian (Hoffmann <i>et al.</i> 2007) and Hwang <i>et al.</i> 2008) and non-mammalian (Zheng <i>et al.</i> 2007; Gunnarsen <i>et al.</i> 2010; and de Vooght <i>et al.</i> 2012) cell lines.
	In Western blotting of bacterial extracts the antibody has been shown not to cross-react with any endogenous products, although some cross-reactivity may be seen with extracts of insect or mammalian cells.
	This antibody is routinely tested in Western blotting on histidine tagged recombinant proteins and reacts against all histidine-tagged proteins so far tested.
Flow Cytometry	Use 10ul of the suggested working dilution to label 1x10 <sup>6</sup> cells in 100ul.

Storage	Store at +4°C or at -20°C if preferred.  This product should be stored undiluted.  Storage in frost free freezers is not recommended.
