<b>Specificity</b>	<b>Mouse anti Human CD112 antibody, clone R2-525</b> recognizes CD112, also known as Poliovirus Receptor Related 2, PRR2 or Nectin-2, a surface molecule originally reported to be homologous to CD155, the poliovirus receptor ( <a href="#">Lopez et al. 1998</a> ). PRR2 expression is restricted to the myelo-monocytic and megakaryocytic lineages. PRR2 expression has also been detected on haematopoietic progenitors expressing CD34.
<b>Flow Cytometry</b>	Use 10ul of the suggested working dilution to label 10 <sup>6</sup> cells in 100ul.
