<b>Specificity</b>	<p><b>Rat anti Human CD137 antibody, clone JG1.6A</b> recognizes human CD137, an 83kD type I integral membrane protein, otherwise known as 4-1BB. The CD137 molecule is primarily expressed on activated T-cells. It is a costimulatory member of the tumour necrosis receptor family and is reported to regulate T-cell activation and proliferation.</p> <p>Rat anti Human CD137 antibody, clone JG1.6A has been reported for use in functional studies.</p>
<b>Flow Cytometry</b>	Use 10ul of the suggested working dilution to label $1 \times 10^6$ cells in 100ul.
