Product Information	<b>The Bovine Interferon Gamma Kit</b> is specific for bovine interferon gamma (IFN-gamma), a secreted cytokine involved in anti-viral activity and growth regulation belonging to the type II interferon family.
	IFN-gamma is produced by lymphocytes in response to activation by specific antigens or mitogens. In addition to its anti-viral activity, IFN-gamma has important immunoregulatory functions in the activation of macrophages and anti-proliferative effects upon transformed cells.
Test Principle	This assay is based on a sandwich ELISA using two different mouse anti bovine IFN-gamma monoclonal antibodies and a recombinant bovine IFN-gamma as a standard.

Intended Use	<b>Bovine Interferon gamma ELISA KIt</b> (MCA5638KZZ) is an ELISA kit (5 x 96 wells) designed for the quantitive determination of bovine interferon gamma (BoIFN-gamma) in bovine serum, plasma and culture supernatant.
	This assay can measure BoIFN-gamma in the range 0.025-50 ng/ml in bovine serum, plasma and culture supernatant. Detailed instructions for use of the kit can be found <u>here</u> .
