<b>Specificity</b>	<p><b>Mouse anti Human myoglobin (clone 164.3A4)</b> is a monoclonal antibody recognizing human myoglobin, a single-chain globular ~17kDa protein containing a heme prosthetic group localized to skeletal muscle. Myoglobin is responsible for the storage and movement of oxygen in muscle tissue.</p> <p>Myoglobin is released from injured muscle into the bloodstream, making it a sensitive marker for all muscle injury. It is commonly used in combination with troponin as a marker for myocardial damage in heart attacks. It is filtered by the kidneys, but is a potential cause of renal failure as it is toxic to the renal tubular epithelium (<a href="#">Lima et al. 2008</a>).</p>
<b>Storage</b>	<p>This product is shipped at ambient temperature. It is recommended to aliquot and store at -20°C on receipt. When thawed, aliquot the sample as needed. Keep aliquots at 2-8°C for short term use (up to 4 weeks) and store the remaining aliquots at -20°C.</p> <p>Avoid repeated freezing and thawing as this may denature the antibody. Storage in frost-free freezers is not recommended.</p>
