CD8 is a heterodimeric protein composed of disulphide-linked CD8 $\alpha$ and <u>CD8</u> $\beta$ chains that is expressed primarily on cytotoxic T-cells. CD8 functions in the interaction with MHC Class I-bearing targets and plays a role in T-cell-mediated killing ( <u>Nakauchi , H. <i>et al.</i>, 1985</u> & <u>Nakauchi, H. <i>et al.</i>, 1987</u> ).
	Clone KT15 is reported to block T-cell-mediated cytotoxicity in <i>in vitro</i> assays (Zeis, M. et <u>al., 2002</u> ).
Flow Cytometry	Use 10ul of the suggested working dilution to label 10 <sup>6</sup> cells in 100ul.
	The Fc region of monoclonal antibodies may bind non-specifically to cells expressing low affinity Fc receptors. This may be reduced by using SeroBlock FcR ( <u>BUF041A/B</u> ).
