Specificity	 Mouse anti Human CD279 antibody, clone EH12.2H7 detects <u>CD279</u>, a co-stimulatory molecule also known as programmed cell death-1 (PD-1). CD279 is a ~50-55 kDa membrane protein which is a member of the CD28 family, and functions as a regulator of T cell activation (Fife and Pauken, 2011). It has two specific ligands; CD274 (PD-L1) and CD273 (PD-L2), and their interaction is key in the balance between stimulatory and inhibitory signals needed for effective immune responses to microbes and self-tolerance. CD279 is a marker for germinal center-associated T cells (Dorfman <i>et al</i>, 2006) and is inducibly expressed by T cells, B cells, NKT cells and monocytes upon activation.
