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Specificity	<p>Mouse anti Human A2M antibody, clone M5, recognizes alpha-2-macroglobulin (A2M), also known as CPAMD5. A2M is a major proteinase inhibitor, with the ability to bind most proteinases and many growth factors, hormones and cytokines in human blood and tissue (Kurz et al. 2017). A2M is largely produced by the liver under conditions of stress, and is then secreted into the blood and extracellular spaces. It is also produced locally by macrophages, fibroblasts, and epithelial cells (Kim et al. 2017).</p> <p>A2M levels dramatically decrease as humans age, a process which has been hypothesized to facilitate tumor development. In naked mole rats, a species with pronounced resistance to cancer, A2M has been shown to inhibit tumor growth regardless of tumor origin (Kurz et al. 2017).</p> <p>The biotinylated Mouse anti Human A2M antibody, clone M5 (MCA6217B) can be used as a detection antibody in a sandwich ELISA with the purified Mouse anti Human A2M antibody, clone M17 (MCA6216GA) as the capture antibody.</p>
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Storage	<p>This product is shipped at ambient temperature. It is recommended to aliquot and store at -20°C on receipt. When thawed, aliquot the sample as needed. Keep aliquots at 2-8°C for short term use (up to 4 weeks) and store the remaining aliquots at -20°C.</p> <p>Avoid repeated freezing and thawing as this may denature the antibody. Storage in frost-free freezers is not recommended.</p>
