Specificity	Mouse anti human STAM2 antibody, clone CD01-1D7 recognizes signal transducing adaptor molecule 2, also known as Hrs-binding protein.
	STAM2 is a subunit of the ESCRT-0 complex and functions as a regulator of receptor signaling and trafficking. Studies have revealed that STAM2 is highly expressed in the brain and specifically localizes to the nucleus in neurons, suggesting that STAM2 might have a specific function in the nervous system (Kapuralin et al. 2015). In gastric cancer, knockdown of STAM2 inhibits cell proliferation and cell migration through affecting the JAK2/STAT3 signaling pathway (Yang et al. 2021).
Western Blotting	Mouse anti Human STAM2 antibody detects a band of 66 kDa in MCF-7 cell lysates
Storage	This product is shipped at ambient temperature. It is recommended to aliquot and store at -20°C on receipt. When thawed, aliquot the sample as needed. Keep aliquots at 2-8°C for short term use (up to 4 weeks) and store the remaining aliquots at -20°C. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing as this may denature the antibody. Storage in frost-free freezers is not recommended.
