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**Product Information** **Recombinant Bovine CXCL9** is a recombinant protein corresponding to aa 22 - 125 of bovine CXCL9, also known as MIG (monokine induced by Interferon-gamma). CXCL9 is a member of the CXC family of chemokine receptors, secreted by interferon stimulated monocytes, macrophages and endothelial cells, which signals through binding to CD183 (CXCR3). CXCL9 acts as a Th1 (type 1 helper T) cell chemoattractant and plays a role in the growth, activation and movement of cells associated with immune and inflammatory responses, and in tumour growth inhibition.

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**Purity** >95% by SDS PAGE analysis

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**ELISA** This reagent may be used as a standard in a sandwich ELISA assay in conjunction with [AHP2369](#) as a coating antibody and [AHP2369B](#) as a detection antibody.
