	Gal-3 is implicated in many biological processes, including cell differentiation, growth, adhesion, angiogenesis and inflammation, and is expressed in a wide range of neoplasms. Gal-3 acts as a regulator of tumor metastasis, and expression correlates with tumor progression in liver, thyroid, colon, gastric and breast carcinomas.
