**Product Information**    **Recombinant Pig tumor necrosis factor alpha** (TNF alpha), also known as tumor necrosis factor ligand superfamily member 2 (TNFSF2), corresponds to aa 77-232 of native pig TNF alpha. This recombinant protein is produced in yeast cells and is naturally folded and post translationally modified.

Pig TNF alpha is produced by a range of cells, including macrophages, monocytes, T and B lymphocytes and is an important mediator of the porcine inflammatory response.

This product may be used as a standard in immunoassays.
