Mouse anti Human TIM-4 antibody, clone rAB04-3G2, is a recombinant monoclonal antibody that recognizes TIM-4, also known as SMUCKLER, T-cell immunoglobulin and mucin domain-containing protein 4 or TIMD-4.

TIM-4 is a ~ 42 kDa type I membrane protein which is preferentially expressed on macrophages, mature dendritic cells, peritoneal B1 cells and invariant natural killer T (iNKT) cells. TIM-4 is the ligand of TIM-1, and binding leads to T-cell proliferation and cytokine production.

Polymorphisms in the TIM-4 gene may be associated with a predisposition to asthma. TIM-4 is expressed in various tumor cells, including lung cancer, colorectal cancer, and certain sarcomas. It can contribute to tumor growth and immune evasion by modulating the tumor microenvironment and promoting angiogenesis.

Flow Cytometry

Use 5µl of the suggested working dilution to label 0.5×10^6 cells in 100µl. Best practices suggest a 5 min centrifugation at 6,000g prior to sample application.

Storage

This product is shipped at ambient temperature. It is recommended to aliquot and store at -20°C on receipt. When thawed, aliquot the sample as needed. Keep aliquots at 2-8°C for short term use (up to 4 weeks) and store the remaining aliquots at -20°C.

Avoid repeated freezing and thawing as this may denature the antibody. Storage in frost-free freezers is not recommended.
