Specificity	<b>Mouse anti Human TATA-box-binding protein antibody</b> recognizes the TATA-box-binding protein, also known as TATA sequence-binding protein, TATA-box binding protein N-terminal domain, TATA-box factor and transcription initiation factor TFIID TBP subunit.		

Initiation of transcription by RNA polymerase II requires the activities of more than 70 polypeptides. The protein that coordinates these activities is transcription factor IID (TFIID), which binds to the core promoter to position the polymerase properly, serves as the scaffold for assembly of the remainder of the transcription complex, and acts as a channel for regulatory signals. TFIID is composed of the TATA-binding protein (TBP) and a group of evolutionarily conserved proteins known as TBP-associated factors or TAFs. TAFs may participate in basal transcription, serve as coactivators, function in promoter recognition or modify general transcription factors (GTFs) to facilitate complex assembly and transcription initiation. TBP gene encodes TBP, the TATA-binding protein. A distinctive feature of TBP is a long string of glutamines in the N-terminus. This region of the protein modulates the DNA binding activity of the C terminus, and modulation of DNA binding affects the rate of transcription complex formation and initiation of transcription. The number of CAG repeats encoding the polyglutamine tract is usually 32-39, and expansion of the number of repeats increases the length of the polyglutamine string and is associated with spinocerebellar ataxia 17, a neurodegenerative disorder classified as a polyglutamine disease. Two transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for TBP (provided by RefSeq, Feb 2010)

Mouse anti Human TATA-box-binding protein antibody detects a band of 40 kDa. The antibody has been extensively validated for western blotting using whole cell lysates.

Lysate Reconstitution	- If using DDT reconstitute the lyophilized lysate with 190µl DI H <sub>2</sub> O, add 200µl 2x Laemmli Sample Buffer and 10µl 2M DTT.
	- If using BME reconstitute the lyophilized lysate with 180µl DI H <sub>2</sub> O, add 200µl 2x Laemmli Sample Buffer and 20µl BME.
	Heat at 95°C for 5 minutes. For 10 well mini gels load 25µl. For other gel and comb formats please refer to the PrecisionAb western blotting protocol.
Storage	Antibody: Store undiluted at -20°C, avoiding repeated freeze thaw cycles.
	Lysate: Store lyophilized lysate at -20°C. After reconstitution aliquot and store at -20°C for up to 3 months or at -80°C for longer term storage.
